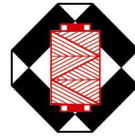

BOM 6

Flying Geese with patchwork block

Method: introduced corners and paper piecing

Pattern: Flying Geese

Block with Ninepatch

Block size finished: 10.0 x 10.0 cm

Block size cut: 11.5 x 11.5 cm

Flying Geese

Block size finished: 5.0 x 10.0 cm

Block size cut: 6.5 x 11.5 cm

Fabrics used:

For the block

Fabric A, K, R	Block / Ninepatch
Fabric B,	Block / edge strip
Fabric N	Block / corner squares

For Flying Geese

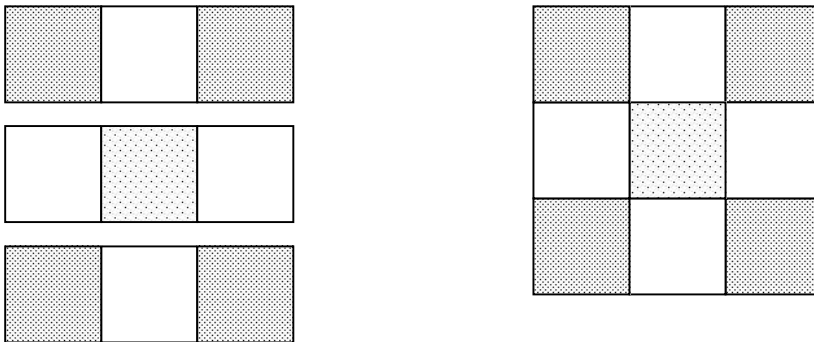
Fabric M, N, O, P	triangle
Fabric light natural	background
Fabric K	narrow edge

Cutting

Fabric A	4 x	3.5 x 3.5 cm
Fabric K	4 x	3.5 x 3.5 cm
Fabric R	1 x	3.5 x 3.5 cm
Fabric B	4 x	3.5 x 7.5 cm
Fabric N	4 x	3.5 x 3.5 cm

Method: Ninepatch and introduced corners

Ninepatch is a block consisting of 9 squares, therefore the name Ninepatch. These 9 squares are put together to three rows with 3 squares each. The 3 rows are sewn on each other.



This Ninepatch gets a border consisting of edge strips. For this, sew 2 strips of fabric B onto the central square (Ninepatch) on two opposite sides (see diagram1).

The two other strips of fabric B are first put together with the corner squares. For this, sew a corner square of fabric N on one end each. Only then, sew the composed strips on the central square (see diagram2).

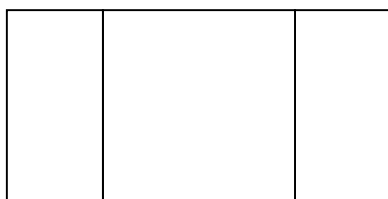

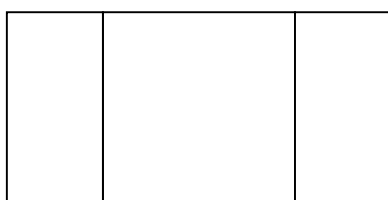
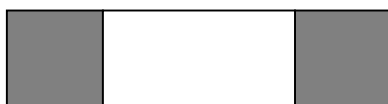

Flying Geese

Preparation:

The two patterns already include a seam allowance of 0.75 cm drawn all around. Copy the patterns directly onto Paper Solvy and cut out with the indicated seam allowance.

Note:

If the pattern is printed onto Paper Solvy with an ink jet printer, care must be taken that the ink is waterproof.

For safety reasons print, sew, and wash out a trial block at any rate.

Sewing:

Finish the two Flying Geese patterns in accordance with the "Paper piecing" technique (see Lesson BOM 4, too).

Washing out:

Remove Paper Solvy by immersing it into water. Dry the block carefully by ironing and if necessary, cut to the specified size.

Finishing:

Sew the two Flying Geese pattern on the right and left to the block.
