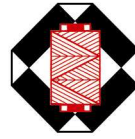

BOM 5 Log-Cabin Blocks

Method: Log-Cabin and Needle-turn Appliqué
Pattern: Star and Log-Cabin block

Block size finished: 10.0 x 10.0 cm
Block size cut: 11.5 x 11.5 cm

Method: Log – Cabin

The Log-Cabin block is one of the most well-known patchwork patterns. Further strips are sewn around a central square in rounds. Depending on the number of rounds, the block may be enlarged to any size.

Traditionally, the central square consisted of red fabric and was a symbol for oven fire in the hut. Often one half of the block sewn consisted of light fabrics and the other half of dark fabrics. These blocks were arranged to be further superior patterns.

Fabrics used:

The following fabrics were used for each block:

2 different beige, 3 different red, and 4 different green fabrics.

In order to design 6 blocks in total in a possibly varied way, the individual fabrics were exchanged by each other. As a result, the fabrics used appear in different places in the individual blocks.

One of the Log-Cabin blocks gets a star as appliqué (see BOM 1 Needle-turn appliqué lesson, too)

Cutting:

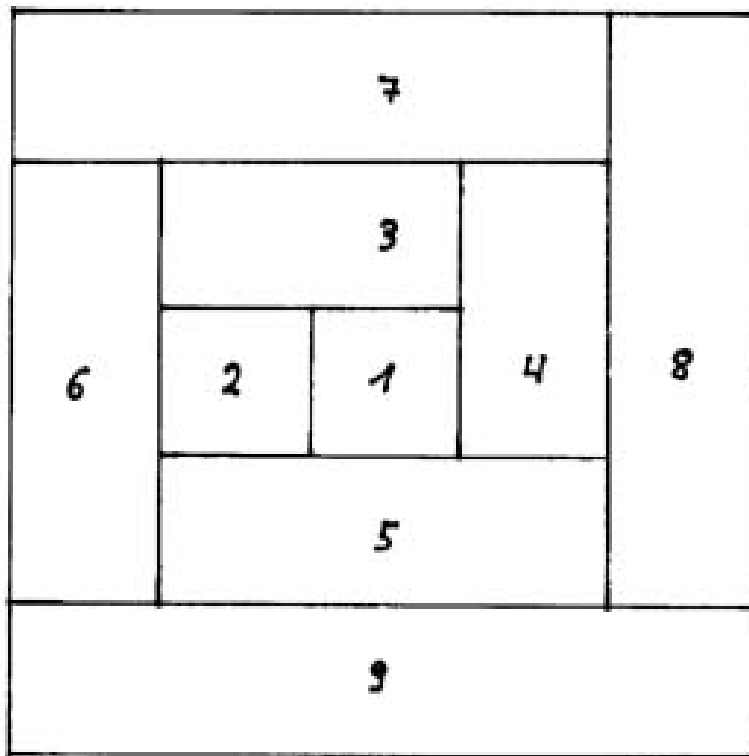
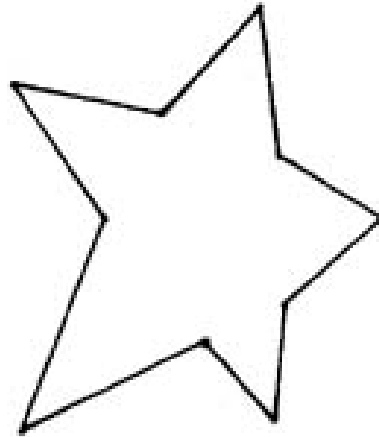
Cut the following strips for each block. The continuous number indicates the position of the strip within the block (see Log-Cabin block pattern, too).

Sew the individual Log-Cabin blocks and applique a bright yellow star on one of the blocks.
