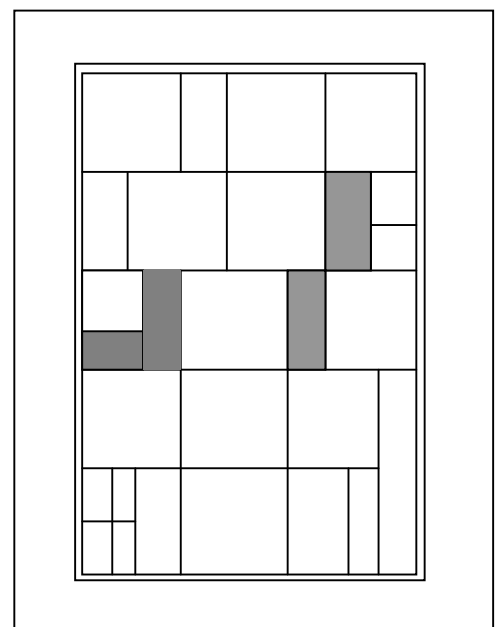
Christmas tree variant, small star

Technique

Christmas tree sewing-by-numbers
on Tear Easy and traditional patchwork

Pattern

Christmas tree



Christmas tree

Row 2 block 4 and row 3 block 4

Finished block size: 6 x 12 inch

Block size with seam margin: 6 ½ x 12 ½ inch

This block is sewn twice.

Small star

Row 3 block 1b

Finished block size: 4 x 4 inch

Block size with seam margin: 4 ½ x 4 ½ inch

This star is sewn x 5 and sewn around the heart row 3 block 1.

Materials used

Christmas tree for row 2

Beige 8

Green 7, 9 and 10

Rust 1

Christmas tree for row 3

Blue 3

Green 8, 9 and 12

Brown 4

Small star

Beige 7

Red 4

Instructions

Sewing the Christmas tree variant

Transfer the Christmas tree patterns onto Tear Easy and finish using the "Sewing by Numbers" method.

1st Step

Cut the material parts according to the pattern.

2 1/2 inch square

4 x Beige 7

4 x red 4

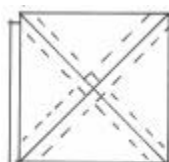
1 7/8 inch squares

1 x red 4

4 x Beige 7

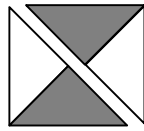
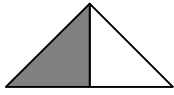
2nd Step

Place the beige and red materials for the two-colour squares (2 ½ inch) right on right and stitch them ¼ inch (wide) left and right from the diagonal out. Then cut through the centre (see diagram).



3rd Step:

Make two-coloured triangles from the squares. Then join them together to make squares.



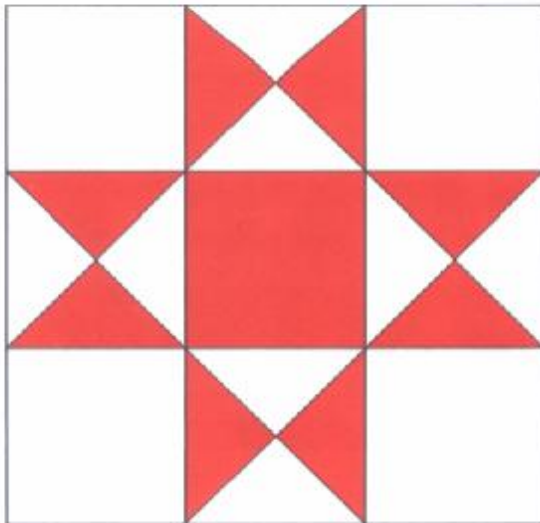
4th Step

Sew the squares together into rows as shown in the pattern.

5th Step

Join the individual rows together.
