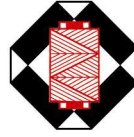

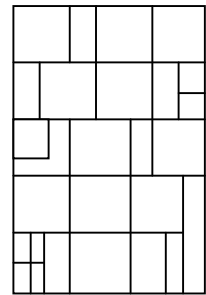
“BLOCK OF THE MONTH”

BOM 11 – FINISHING

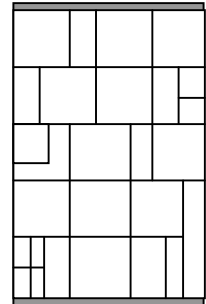
1st Step

Sew the blocks together as shown in the pattern diagram.



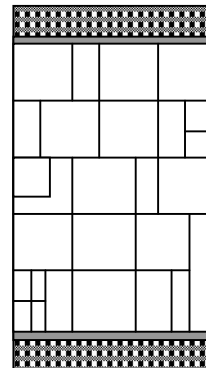
2nd Step

Cut 2 inch thick strips from the left over material and sew together. Sew the strips onto the top and bottom edges of the joined blocks.



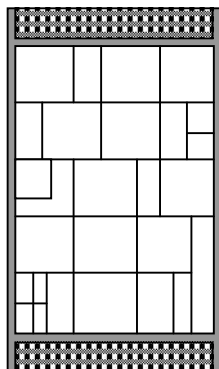
3rd Step

Sew together 7 stars each for the top and bottom edges. Then sew on the star strips.



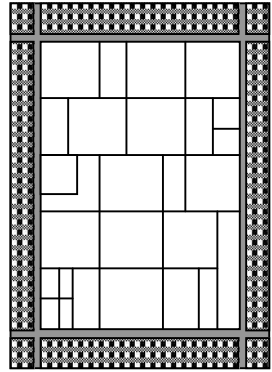
4th Step

Cut 2 inch thick strips from the left over material and sew together. Sew the strips onto the side edges.



5th Step

Sew together 10 stars each for the right and left edges.
Add a 2 inch wide strip to both outside edges.
Apply another star to both the right and left.
These stars form the corners.



Finishing

6th Step

Make a further 2 inch wide strip for the outside edge and sew it around the entire outside edge of the quilt.

Quilting

Cut the fleece and the reverse side material slightly larger than the front side. Secure all 3 layers together using safety pins. Quilt rings around the individual blocks using a decorative stitch, using COTTOC 30 MULTICOLOR as top and bottom threads.

Edging

Cut the fleece and reverse side material to the size of the front side.

A 2-inch wide strip is required for an all-round foot-width ($\frac{1}{4}$ inch) border.

Cut 2 inch-wide strips from the remaining material.

Join the strips together by placing them right to right at 90o and stitching through the diagonal. Cut off the excess margin and iron the stitching in one direction.

Sew on the resulting long strip of material right to right on the front of the cover, flush to the edge, $\frac{1}{4}$ inch wide.

At each corner sew the seam $\frac{1}{4}$ inch away from the edge.

Fold the material strip upwards once at a right angle and fold down once, so that the material strip lies flush to the side of the next edge seam. Then sew this side with $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam margin. Continue for the entire edge of the cover. Iron the seam margin and the corners and pin the reverse side of the cover over the seam of the border.

Sew the material layers together again at the seams of the front.
