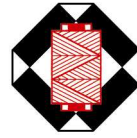
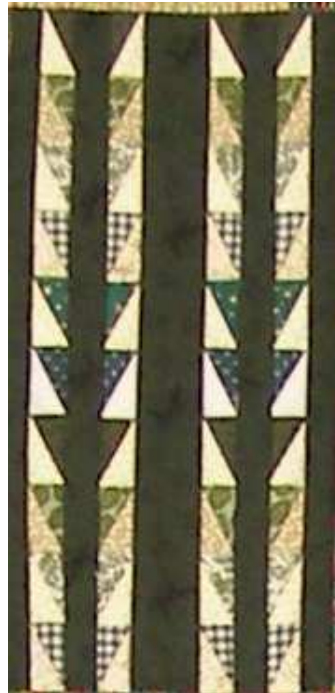

Christmas tree – snippet

Technique

Sewing by numbers on Paper Solvy

Pattern

Segments for the Christmas tree

Row 1, block 2

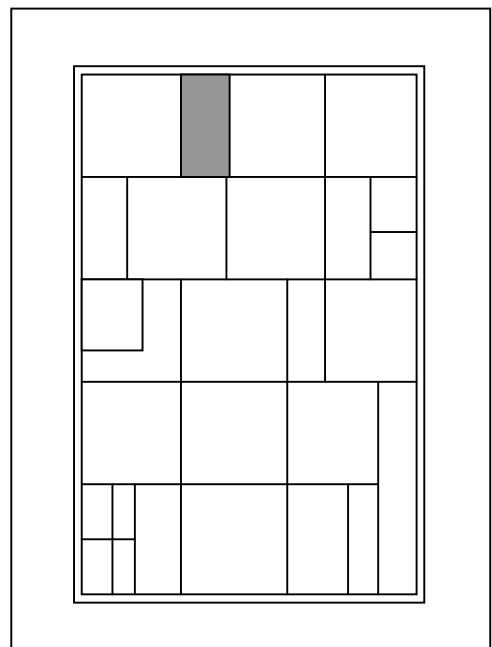
Finished block size: 6 x 12 inch

Block size with seam margin: 6 ½ x 12 ½ inch

Materials used

Green 7 edging

Remnants from beige 1, 4, 5, 6 and green 1, 3, 4, 5, 7 and 11



Information

If the pattern is printed on Paper Solvy using an ink jet printer, you must make sure that the ink is waterproof.

To make sure you should always do a sample print, sew and then wash out.

Instructions

1st Step

Copy the pattern directly onto Paper Solvy and cut out the segments A, D, B and C each with a seam margin of 1/4 inch. Stick on the extensions of the individual parts using KK 2000 (other temporary spray glue).

2nd Step

Cut the individual materials into handy pieces of approx. 10 x 20cm. These are perfect for the "sewing by numbers" method. Small remnants left over from work can be reused for smaller parts. Stick the material part for number one onto the corresponding place on the reverse side of the Paper Solvy with its right side facing up. Stick the material for part 2 right to right on part 1 and fix with pins.

3rd Step

Turn the Paper Solvy around and sew along the sewing line between areas 1 and 2 using stitch length 1.5". Start just before the beginning of the line and end just before the line does.

4th Step

Unfold part 2 and iron. Cut back the seam margins to a width of 1/4 inches.

5th Step

Sew all of the following material parts up to no. 20 in the same way. For segments A and B add numbers 21 and 22.

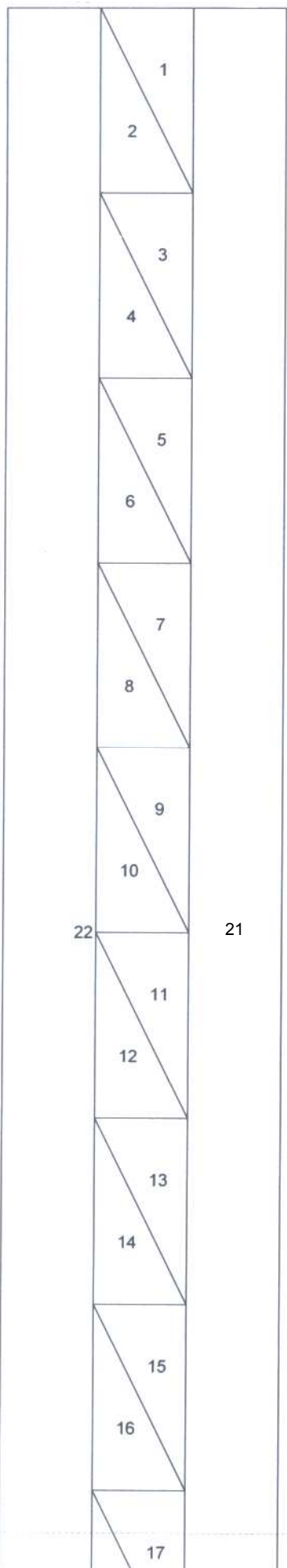
6th Step

Join segments A and D and segments B and C together. Then sew segment A/D and segment B/C together.

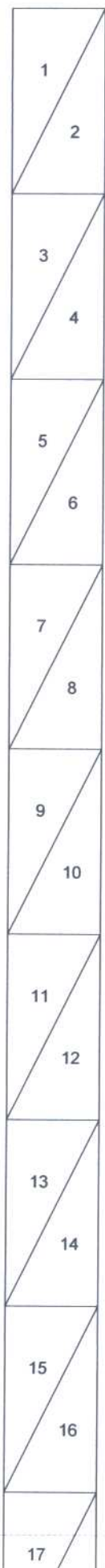
7th Step

Remove the Solvy paper by submerging in water. Then carefully dry the block.

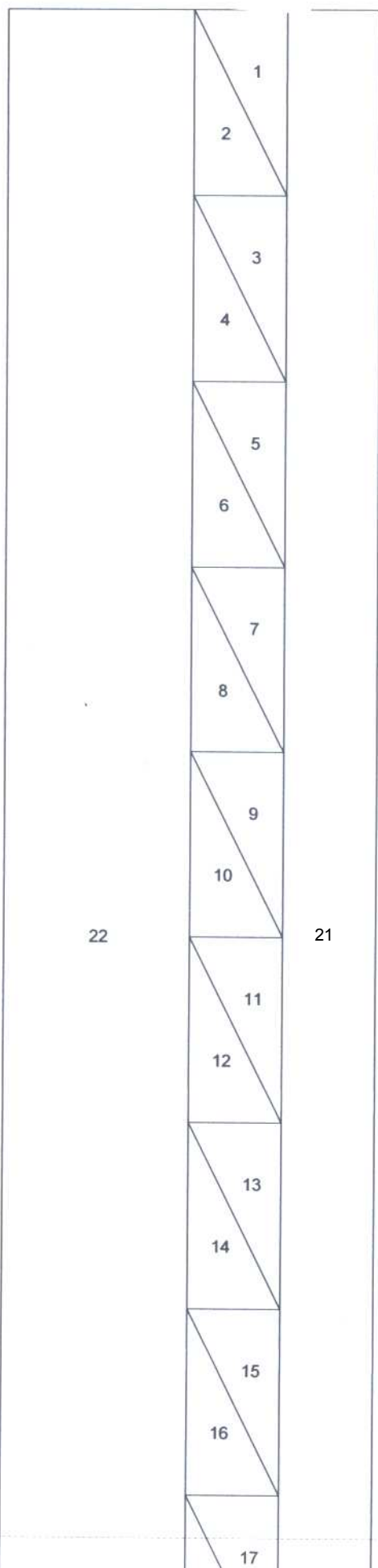
