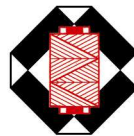

Friendship stars, stars

Technique

Traditional patchwork

Small friendship stars

Row 4, block 4

Row 5 block 4a and 5

Finished block size: 4 x 4 inch

Block size with seam margin: 4 ½ x 4 ½ inch

This block is sewn twice.

Large friendship stars

Row 4, block 4

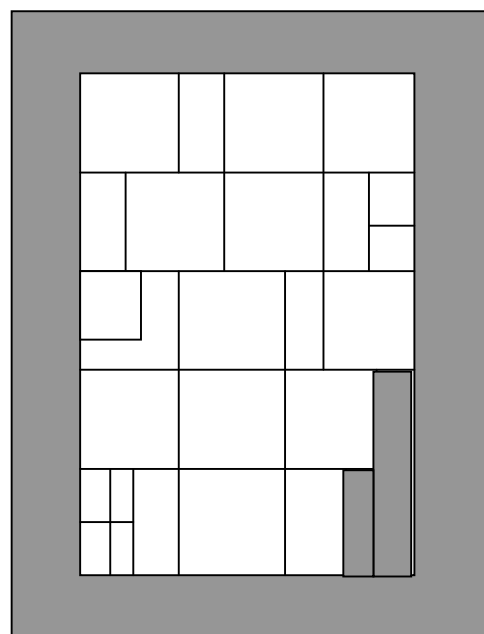
Row 5 block 4a and 5 Finished block size: 6 x 6 inch

Block size with seam margin: 6 ½ x 6 ½ inch

This block is sewn four times.

Stars

Full border



Finished block size: 6 x 6 inch
Block size with seam margin: 6 ½ x 6 ½ inch
This block is sewn 38 times.

Materials used

Small friendship stars

Red 3

Blue 3

Large friendship star

Beige 9

Brown 4

Instructions

Sewing the small star

1st Step

Cut the following material parts for each star as shown in the pattern.

Small friendship stars

1 7/8 inch squares

4 x red 3

1 x blue 3

2 1/8 inch squares

2 x red 3

2 x blue 3

Large friendship stars

2 ½ inch squares

4 x Beige 9

1 x brown 4

2 7/8 inch squares

2 x Beige 9

2 x brown 4

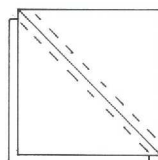
Sewing the small stars (cont.)

2nd Step

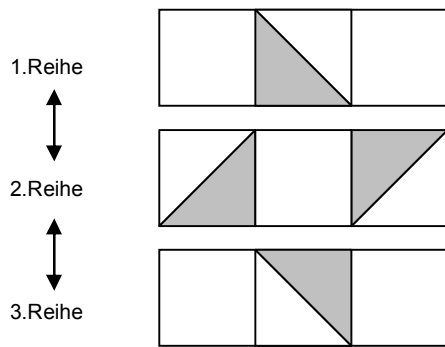
For the small stars place the red and blue material together for the two-colour squares (2 1/8 inch) and for the large star place the beige and blue materials (2 7/8 inch) right on right and stitch 1/4 inch left and right from the diagonal. Then cut through the centre (see diagram).

3rd Step

Join the squares together for each row

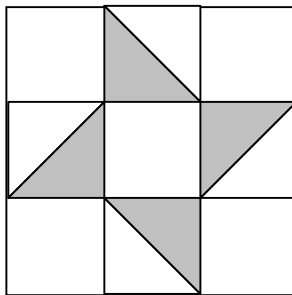


according to the pattern.



4th Step

Join all three rows together.



Instructions

Sewing the stars for the border

1st Step

Cut the following material parts for each star as shown in the pattern.

2 inch squares

4 x Beige 1

4 x blue 1

2 3/8 inch squares

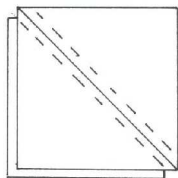
4 x Beige 1

4 x blue 1

2nd Step

Place the beige and blue materials for the two-colour squares (2 3/8 inch) right on right and stitch them

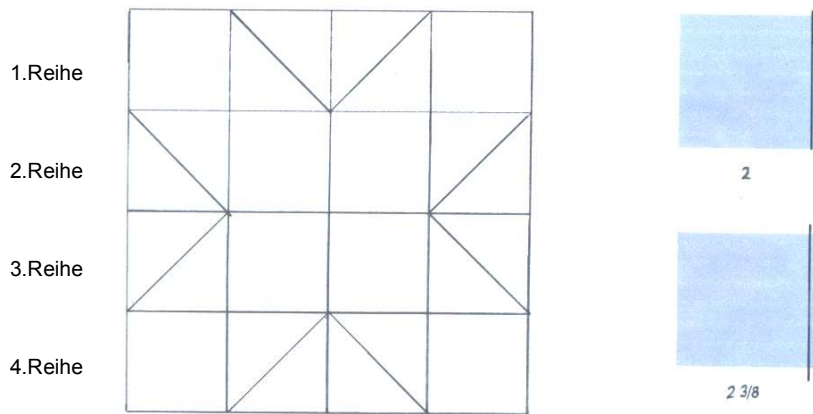
1/4 inch left and right from the diagonal out. Then cut through the centre.



3rd Step

Join the squares together for each row according to

the pattern.



4th Step

Join all four rows together.
