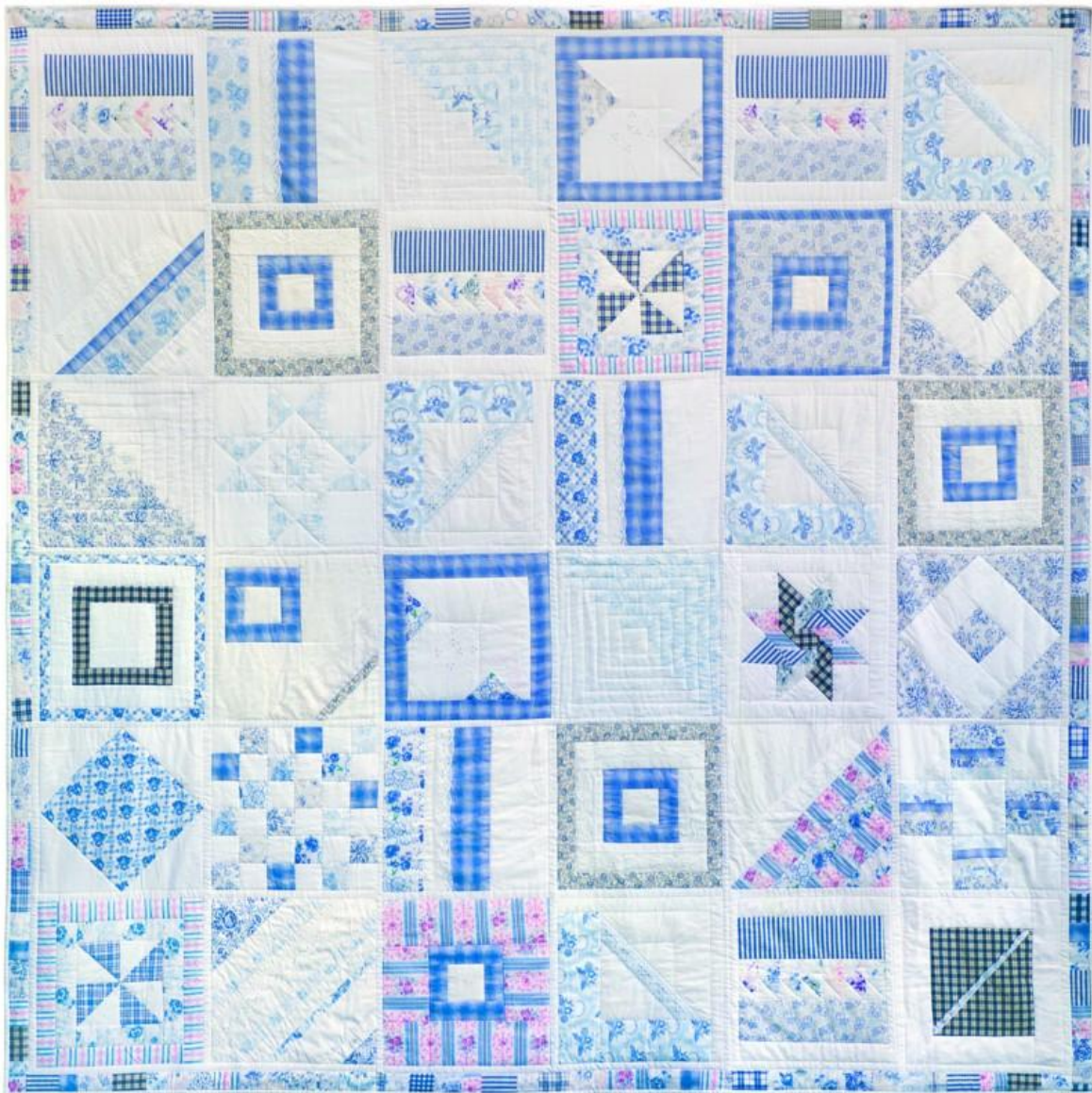

Please note: we haven't given a detailed list of materials to be used for this quilt, because every quilt is supposed to be unique. The instructions will help you to sew a similar quilt using the materials that you have available.

Materials

- 3 reels **COTTON 30** in white (Col. 1002)
- 2.0 m **TEAR EASY** (roll width 50cm)
- 3.0 m padded fleece
- Buttons
- A large collection of old bed linen and table cloths with lace and embroidery in different shades of blue, blue-white and white and some with diamonds and stripes
- Any backing material

Product information

- **COTTON 30:** Machine embroidery and quilting thread made from 100% cotton.
- **TEAR EASY:** Tearable, thick, soft, sticky fleece.

Sizes

- Whole quilt approx. 260 x 260 cm
- Block size finished: 39.0 x 39.0 cm
- Block size cut: 40.5 x 40.5 cm

Seam allowance

- 0.75 cm
A seam allowance of 0.75 cm has already been taken into account in the cutting dimensions.

Important

- The quilt is made of a total of 36 blocks that are all the same size.
- The dimensions given in the individual instructions always refer to a block.
- The number and the position of the blocks come from the diagram below the block description.
- The instructions follow a chessboard pattern.
- The numbers 1-6 describe the vertical rows and the letters A-F describe the horizontal ones.
- The exact colour distribution can be seen from the photo.
