

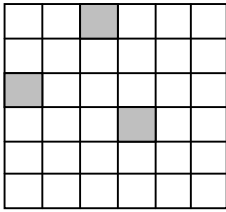

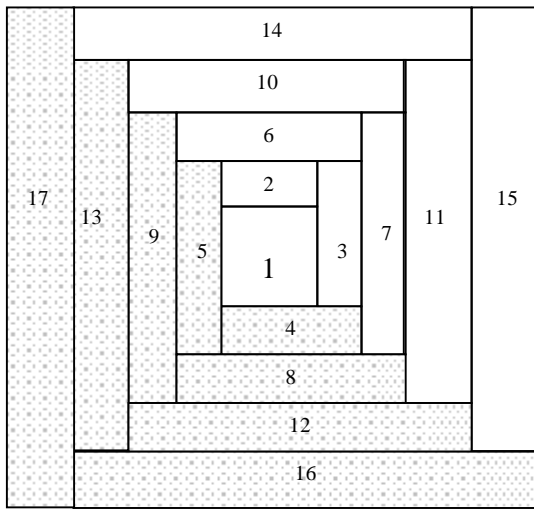

Cut:

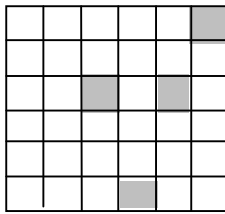
Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
1 centre square	7.5 x 7.5cm	With monogram or blue print
Various strips	4.5cm wide	From white and blue-white fabric

Sewing:

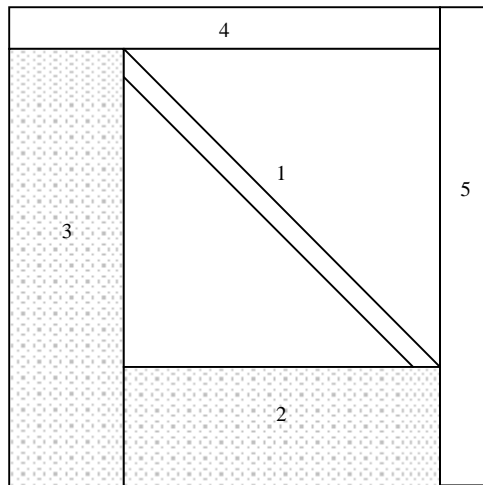
Start on one side with both white strips first (no. 2, no. 3) and then both blue-white strips (no. 4, no. 5). The other strips are sewn on in a clockwise direction according to the sequence shown in the diagram.

Please note: keep sewing until you reach a size of 40.5 x 40.5cm, alternating two white and two blue-white strips.

Cut:

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
1 square (no. 1)	27.5 x 27.5cm	With embroidery
1 strip (no. 2)	11.5 x 27.5cm	Blue-white
1 strip (no. 3)	11.5 x 37.5cm	Blue-white
1 strip (no. 4)	4.5 x 37.5cm	White
1 strip (no. 5)	4.5 x 40.5cm	White

Sewing:

Sew a piece of lace diagonally onto the centre square. First start by sewing both blue-white strips (no. 2, no. 3) onto the square, then both white strips (no. 4, no. 5), following the drawing.
