

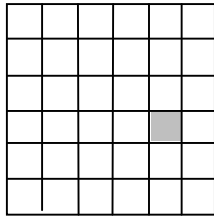

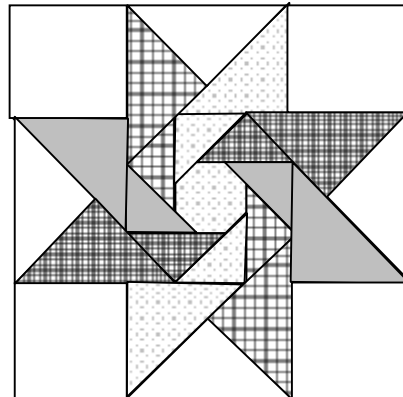

Twisting Star

Cut:

Centre with small squares:

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
1 square	7.0 x 7.0 cm	Blue-white
4 squares	8.0 x 8.0 cm	From various blue-white fabrics

Outside border with star points

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
4 squares	11.5 x 11.5 cm	From various blue-white fabrics
2 squares	11.5 x 11.5 cm	White
4 squares	10.5 x 10.5 cm	White

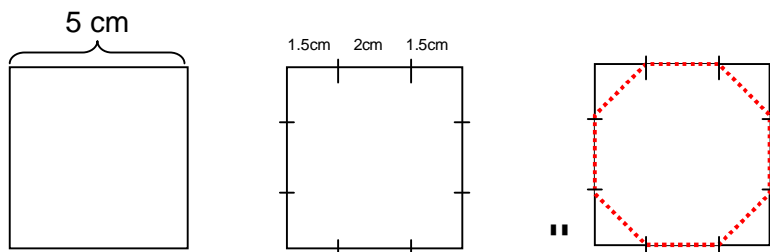
Background

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
2 strips	6.0 x 31.5 cm	White
2 strips	6.0 x 40.5 cm	White

Sewing:

1st Step

Prepare the stencil for the centre: draw a square with 5cm sides. Make marks at distances of 1.5 - 2cm - 1.5cm on each side line. Connect the points you have drawn together to make an octagon. Cut out this octagon and use it as a stencil for the centre.



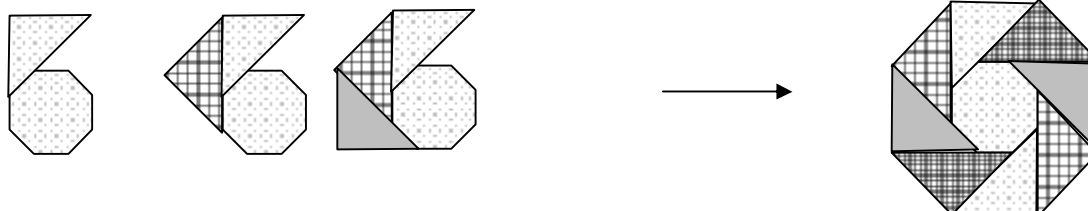
2nd Step

Using the stencil cut an octagon measuring 7 x 7cm out of the fabric square and add a seam allowance.

Divide the 8.0 x 8.0cm fabric square in half diagonally for the small triangles.



First sew the small triangles around the octagon. When sewing on the first triangle, do not completely close the seam. That is only done when the last triangle is sewn on.

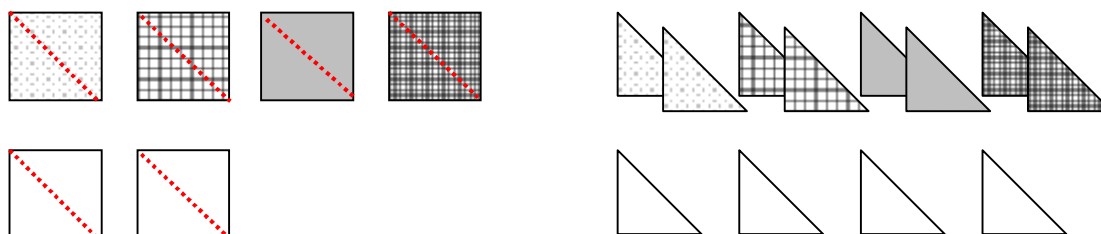


Sew the eight triangles according to the diagram, paying attention to the colour sequence (the colours of triangles no. 1 and no. 4, no. 2 and no. 5, no. 3 and no. 6, no. 4 and no. 8 are identical).

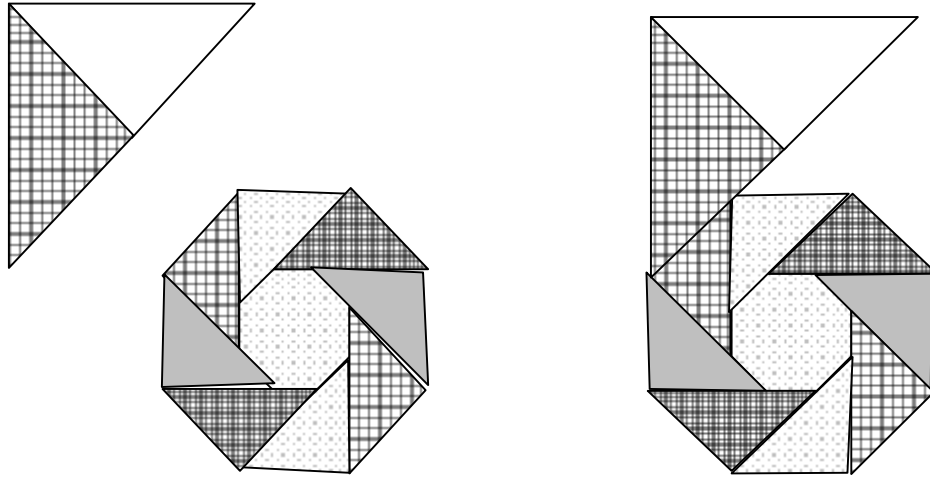
Once the last triangle has been sewn on, close up the incomplete seam.

3rd Step

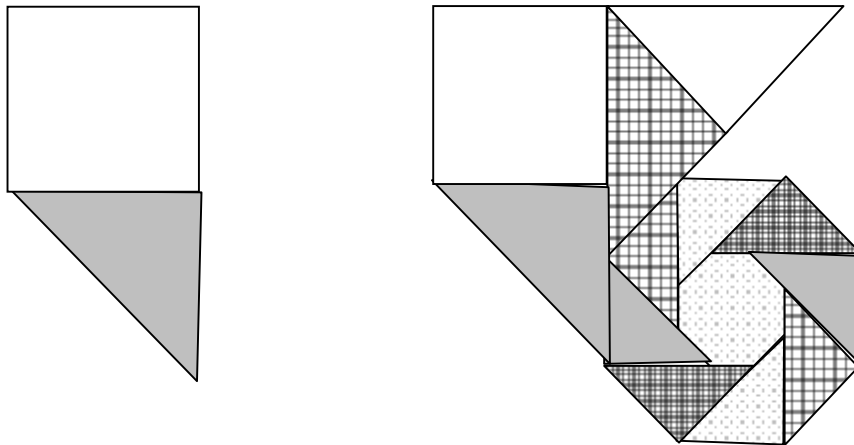
For the large triangles, divide the 11.5 x 11.5cm fabric squares in half diagonally.
 Die 8 Dreiecke der Zeichnung entsprechend annähen, dabei auf die Farbfolge achten, die Farben von Dreieck 1 und 5, 2 und 6, 3 und 7, 4 und 8 sind identisch.
 Nachdem das letzte Dreieck angenäht ist, die unvollständige Naht schließen.



For the border, sew a triangle for the star point and a triangle made from white fabric onto each other and only then sew them onto the octagon.
Again, only close up the first seam up to approximately half.

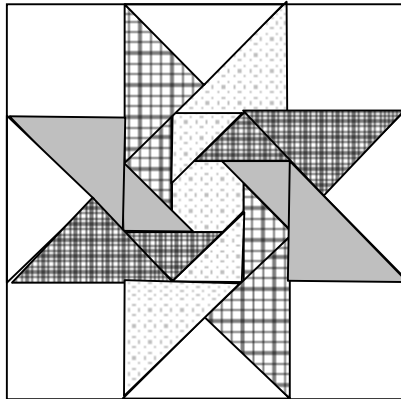
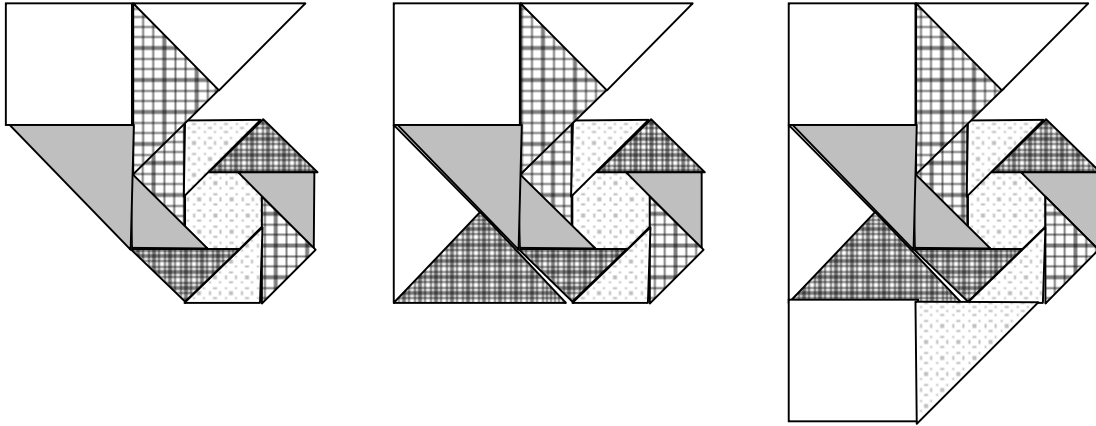


For the four corners sew a triangle (star point) and a white square to each other.



Sew together another triangle for the star point and a triangle from white fabric and sew onto the octagon. Pay attention to the colours of the fabrics.

Keep sewing according to the diagram and finally close the up unfinished seam.



4th Step

Sew both shorter strips to the top and bottom and both longer strips to the right and left.
