

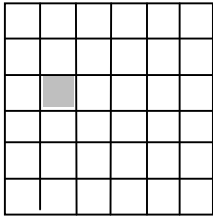

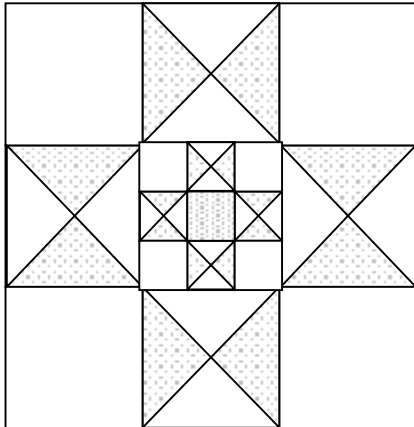

Cut:

Small star (centre)

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
1 centre square	6.0 x 6.0cm	Blue-white
4 squares	6.0 x 6.0cm	White
2 squares	8.0 x 8.0cm	White
2 squares	8.0 x 8.0cm	Blue-white

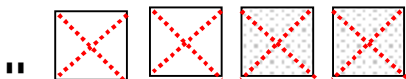
Large star

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
4 corner squares	14.5 x 14.5cm	White
2 squares	16.5 x 16.5cm	White
2 squares	16.5 x 16.5cm	Blue-white

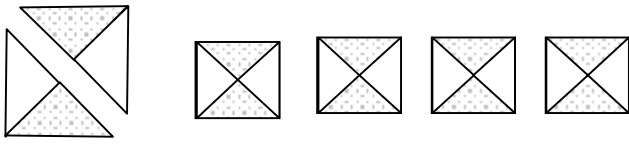
Sewing:

1st Step

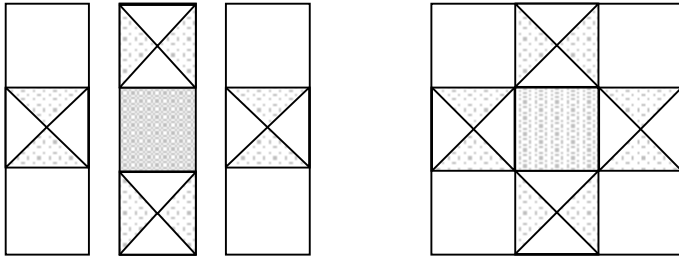
Divide the four 8.0 x 8.0cm squares into quarters diagonally.



For the small star sew two white and two blue-white triangles together.

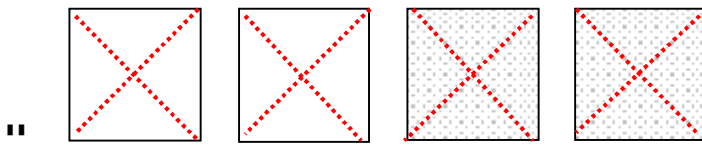


Sew the small star together using the four white squares and the one blue-white centre square. This block is used as the centre square for the large star.

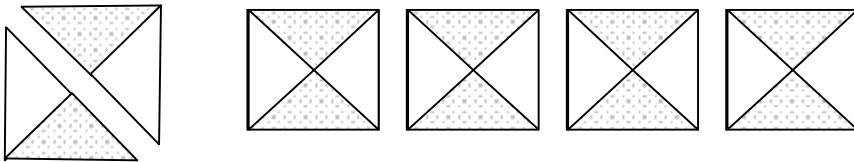


2nd Step

Divide the four 16.5 x 16.5cm squares into quarters diagonally.



For the large star sew two white and two blue-white triangles together.



Using the four white stars and the small star as the centre square, sew together to make the variable star.
