

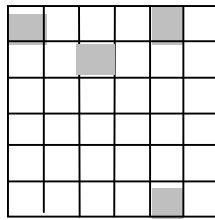

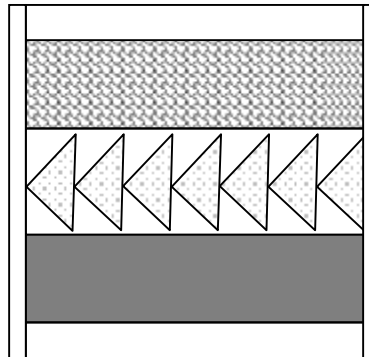

**BOM 9**  
**Flying Geese**



A1, C2, E1, E6



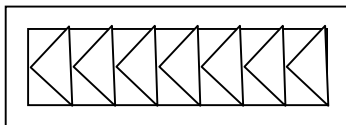
**Cut:**

Fabric parts	Cutting dimensions	Type of fabric
2 strips	11.5 x 36.5 cm	Blue-white
2 strips	6.0 x 36.5 cm	White
2 strips	3.5 x 40.5 cm	White

**Sewing:**

**1<sup>st</sup> Step**

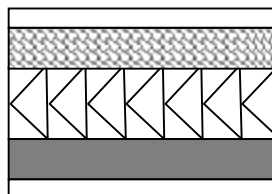
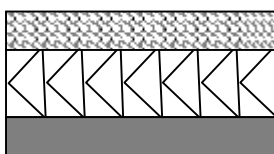
Transfer the flying geese diagram onto **TEAR EASY**. The exact size of the pattern is 10 x 35cm. Cut out the flying geese leaving a seam allowance all the way around.

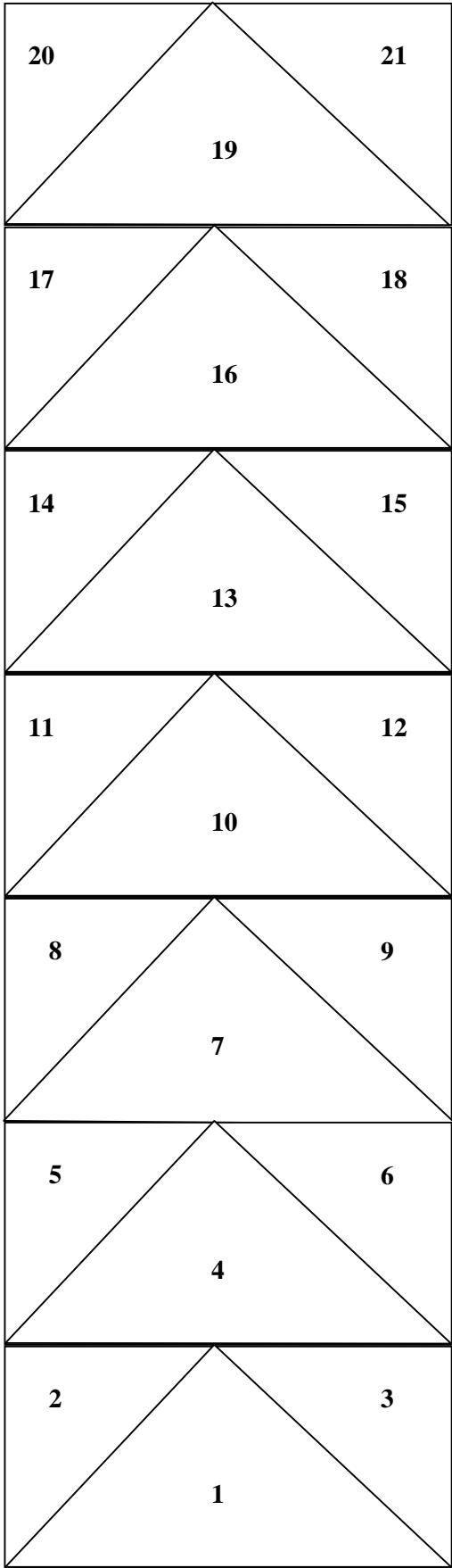


Sew the flying geese using white and blue-white fabric using the “Sewing by Numbers” method. The sequence can be seen in the diagram. Then carefully tear off the **TEAR EASY** from the back.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Step**

Sew both blue-white strips (11.5 x 36.5cm) to the top and bottom of the strips with the flying geese, then both shorter white strips (6.0 x 36.5cm) are sewn onto the top and bottom. Attach both longer white strips (3.5 x 40.5cm) to the right and left following the pattern.
