

BOM 7



House with Window Shutters

Size:

Block size completed	35 x 21 cm
Block size incl. seam allowance	36.5 x 22.5 cm

Cutting:

Cut out the background fabric a little larger than required by the needed block size. While applying, embroidering and ironing, the fabric may be deformed a little. Then it is easier to straighten the fabric afterwards. If you use an embroidery frame, the cut-out must be big enough to be put into the frame.

Draw the contours of the block on the cut-out with a water based marker. This helps with positioning the appliqué motifs.

Distribution of the fabrics:

Background	beige
Houses	dark beige
Roofs	dark beige and gray beige
Tree	green
Tree trunk	dark brown
Landscape lines	different shades of green

Please find the fabrics for details, such as doors and windows, on the photo or select them at your own discretion.

Templates:

Put the two templates 7a, and 7b together along the dotted line.

Completion:

Choose the position of the houses and roofs and apply the motifs as described in the introduction. Apply the tree trunk and the treetop on top.

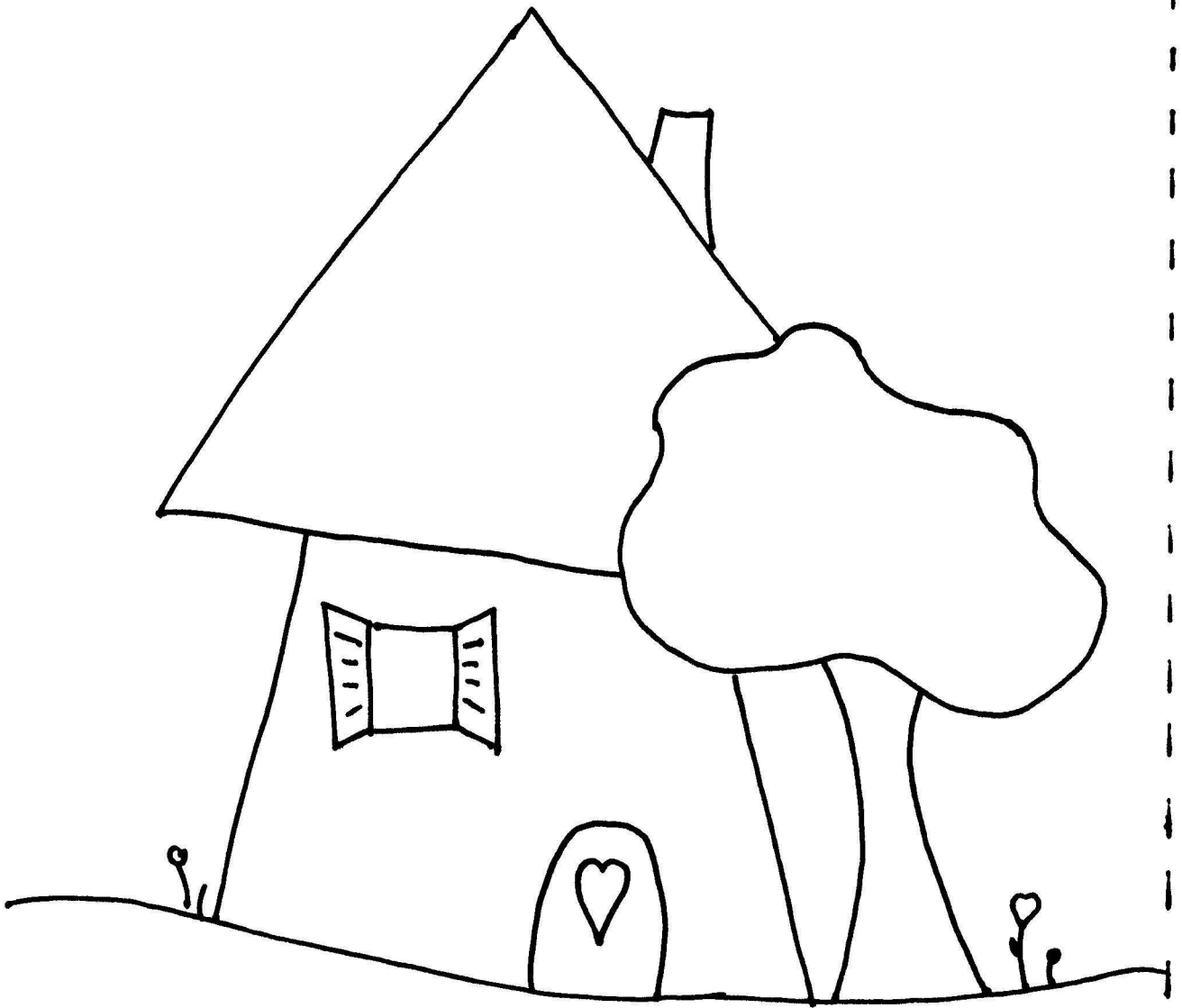
Apply the landscape at the very end, in order to achieve a three-dimensional effect.

Embroidery:

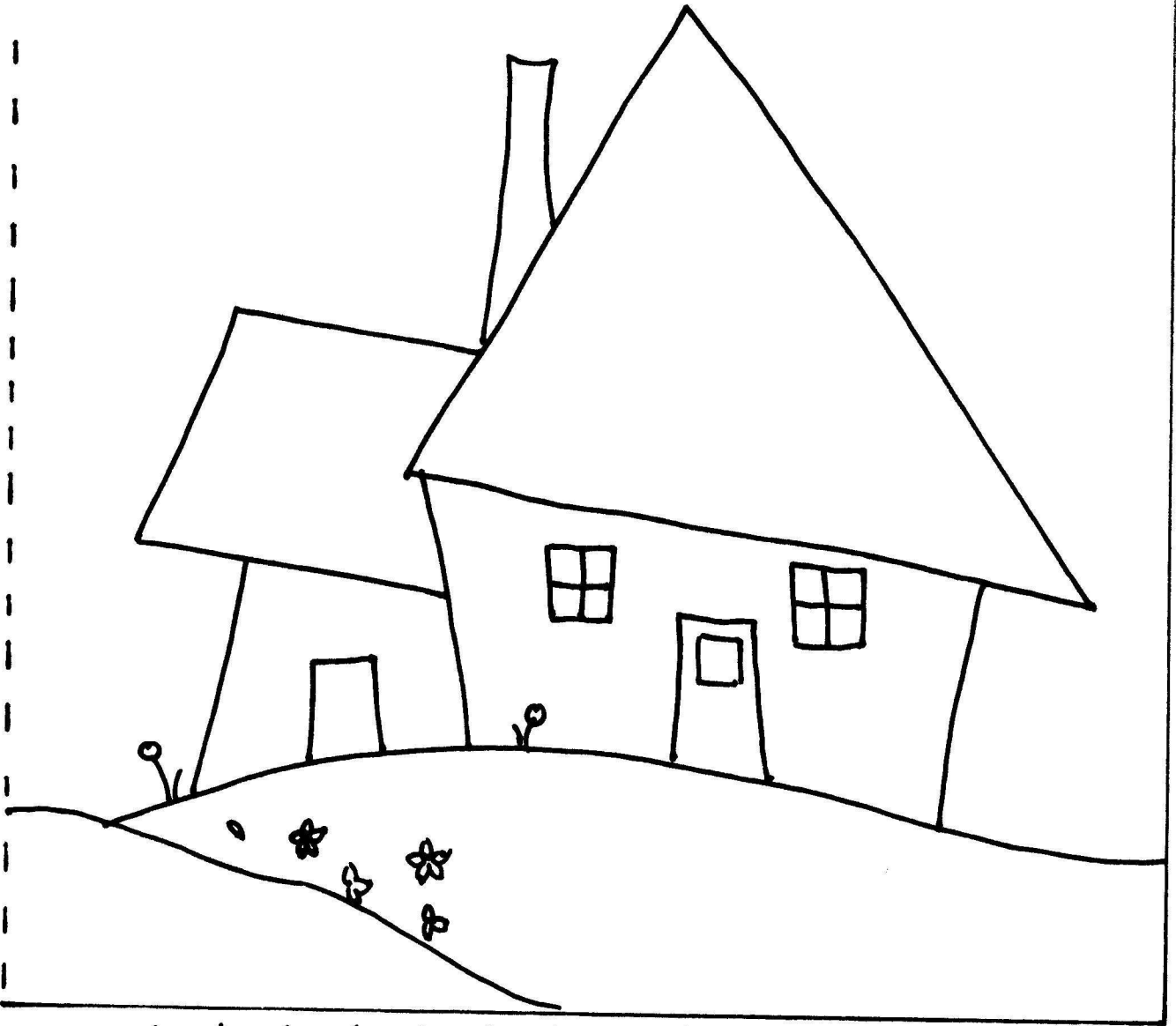
Embroider the window shutters and lattice windows using **COTTON 12** in brown with a stem stitch, and work the flower stems in green. Sew on buttons as blossoms and embroider a few blossoms with a Lazy Daisy.
