

## BOM 12



### Sewing on decorations

Use **Invisible** thread or matching thread to sew on the various decorative elements.

**Block 1**

Sew 3 little mother-of-pearl buttons on the waist of the dressmaker's dummy. In Block 1b sew on various hooks and on the seam between 1b and 1c sew on a paper label e.g. from a spool of thread.

**Block 2**

Sew a small dark grey button on the scissors. Sew on various buttons beneath the embroidered or appliquéd motifs.

**Block 3**

Sew a heart-shaped button in the centre of the line of jewellery on the sewing machine.

**Block 4**

Sew a small dark grey button to form the dot of the 'i' in the lettering. Sew various buttons and the zipper of a zip fastener around the lettering.

**Block 5**

Sew a large snap fastener on the heart and sew a large deco pin on the thread of the spool of thread. Sew a card with buttons on block 5c. For Block 5b knot a button on to a piece of card with white darning cotton and sew these together to Block 5b.

**Block 6**

Similarly on Block 6c sew on a piece of card with a button and on 6b sew safety pins in various sizes.

**Block 7**

Sew a button on the heart; on Block 7b sew various old spools of thread made of card. Embroider a French knot in burgundy in each little rose in Block 7c. This will secure the fabric at each point. Sew a thread shuttle and the ends of two suspenders on the lower edge.

**Block 8**

Sew an old laundry label on the heart and sew an old card of snap fasteners to Block 8b. Sew 2 spools from an old sewing machine on block 8c and sew a card of thread stars on the lower edge.

**Block 9**

Bind a piece of lace over the cover and decorate with a bow. Sew various buttons on the glass of buttons and sew several buttons securely on the edge below it.
